This introductory clinic is designed for youth up to 18 years of age who want to learn the concepts, rules, and principles of polo. The clinic will feature videos, discussion, and hands-on learning.

During the three-day clinic, students will learn:

- ✓ the rules of the game;
- ✓ the four basic mallet strokes,
- ✓ the Line of the Ball (LOB) and the Right of Way;
- ✓ the concept of the Man, Line, Ball Theory and beginning Polo strategy;
- ✓ the proper way to prepare and protect a horse for the game;
- ✓ how to introduce a horse to mallets and balls; and
- ✓ how to play scrimmage games.

Most riders use English saddles, but western saddles may be used. Students should have polo wraps or Pro-Choice boots for their horses, and wear riding boots and helmets.

ABOUT THE INSTRUCTORS

Wilbur O'Ferrall is a Field Director for the Polo Training Foundation and a USPA certified Umpire. Having played since aged ten, Wilbur played for the UC Davis Polo team that won the Pacific Coast Championship four years in a row. He was captain of the team that won the 1989 National Title. In 1990 he was PTF Male Intercollegiate Player of the Year, and elected to the All American Intercollegiate Polo Team. Wilbur teaches polo and umpire clinics throughout the U.S. and Canada.
